


Meet Your Tour Guide, Mr. Mel Brooks


Brooks to be your guide through history? No...but a hologram version is the next best thing.





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

















The Tomb of Jesus: A Collection of Relics
















The Civil War Barracks: Abe's Camp

The Civil War Sports Bar: Coyote Fugly



Want to know which way Rasputin can be assasinated? Spin the "Wheel of Assasination" to find out.






elcome and thank you for volunteering for the Chisholm for President campaign!


Don't be too scared of our living statues. Some of history's most notorious characters spring to life as you walk by and might drop a fun factoid about themselves (whether true or not).

*Potential to ask talent from his films to film a video talking about how much he influenced them that can play on rotations and be circulated to press and integrated into app.














Commercialism at its Finest


































1ST FLOOR PLAN
